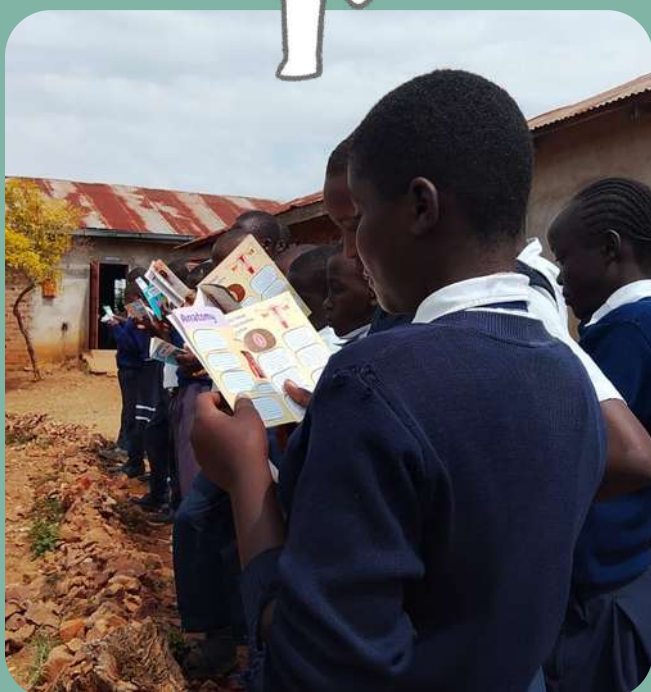

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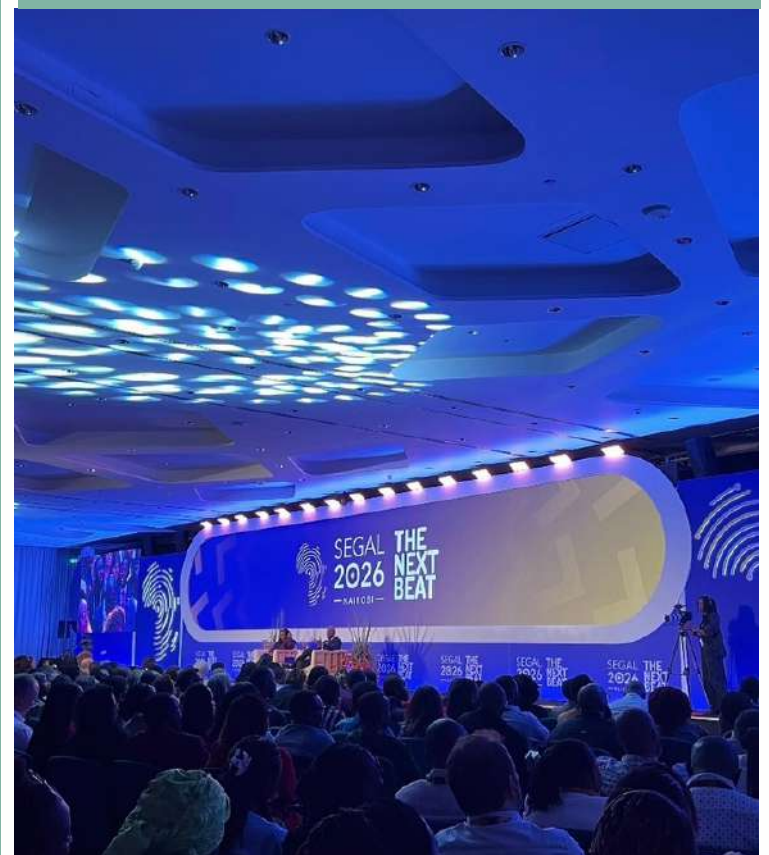
The Segal2026 Conference was a great opportunity for our organization to meet other organizations doing similar work and creating change in their communities



The sessions on Early Stage [Grassroots & Community Led] was such an eye opener on how organizations on their early years overcome some of the challenges they face as they grow.

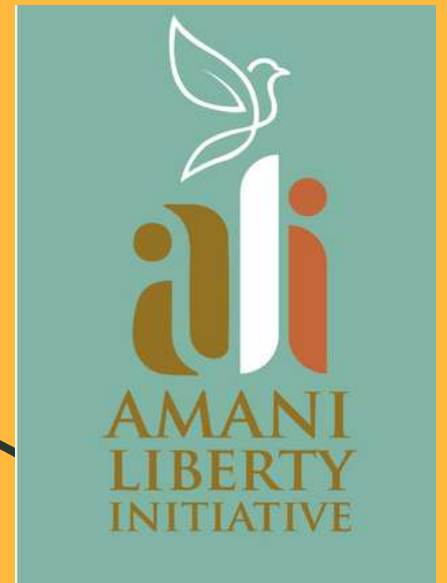

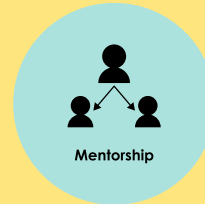
